The Process

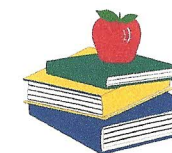
Beginning in early June, students create a list of potential schools to investigate. Over the summer between junior and senior year, students draft required essays and resumes and other required documents to be critiqued so that they can be included with applications. After a list of schools has been created, a binder will be created to track information pertaining both to the student and the schools. By the end of October the application process will be complete. In early November, a massive search for scholarship will commence. Also, during this time ACT scores will be sent. By mid-April, scholarship work will be completed. The process will come to an end with the return of award letters and confirmed acceptances from the desired schools of choice.
